Announcement

The following information is for Version 7.1 of EView/400i Management for Microsoft System Center Operations Manager (EView/400i).

EView/400i allows you to integrate AS/400 or iSeries systems into the System Center Operations Manager (SCOM) environment. As a component of the Microsoft System Center Operations Manager solution, EView/400i extends management of the Microsoft System Center Management environment to OS/400 domains.

EView/400i Management coexists with existing OS/400 management solutions to increase flexibility in managing OS/400 environments. EView/400i monitors the status and health of the OS/400 system and its standard applications.

Updating from a Previous Release of EView/400i

Compatibility Information and Installation Requirements

EView400i Version 7.1 is compatible with Microsoft System Center Operations Manager 2012 R2 and 2016 general releases.

For detailed installation instructions see the *EView/400i Installation Guide*.

New features in this version

In this version 7.1 release, the following features are added:

- Updated ASP and ASP Disk unit monitors to monitor iASP (independent ASP) disks
- A new ASP Disk Utilization unit monitor to monitor utilization for individual disks from ASP #1 (system pools), ASP #2 (user pools) and ASP #33 (independent pools)
- A new Job Queue Status unit monitor to monitor all job queues status, an alert is generated when the job queue changes from RELEASED to HELD state.
- A new performance unit monitor- PERCENT_PERM_ADDRESS, an alert is generated when the threshold of a percentage of permanent addresses is exceeded
- A new performance unit monitor - PERCENT_TEMP_ADDRESS, an alert is generated when the threshold of a percentage of temporary addresses is exceeded
- A new performance unit monitor- NUM_ACTIVE_JOBS, an alert is generated when the threshold of a number of active jobs is exceeded
